MERCED—The Merced County Library wants to hear from residents to help guide its 2021-2024 Strategic Plan.

Surveys will be available to all residents online and at library branches until June 18. Library staff members are hoping to solicit the participation of people from all regions and all segments of the population. The Library will use survey results to help guide the Department's work as it positions services to better meet the needs of the community.
