Response to Questions

1. **Question:** Can you confirm the amount for liquidated damages?

Response: Liquidated damages are \$2,000 per day.

2. **Question:** Is the project 60 working days or 60 calendar days?

Response: 60 calendar days.

3. **Question:** Will water be provided?

Response:

- A. Non-potable water is not available at the project site. Non-potable water for use by the Contractor for Construction or other purposes shall be coordinated by the Contractor at the Contractor's expense.
- B. Potable water is not available at the project site. Potable water for use by the Contractor for Construction or other purposes shall be coordinated by the Contractor at the Contractor's expense.
- C. No provision in this section is intended to prevent the Contractor from making arrangements for water from other than Owner sources. All costs involved shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.

4. **Question:** Can rock material be unloaded directly onto the access road and then expeditiously placed onto the slope or must all rock be unloaded as stated in Section 02371, Part 3.02, #2?

Response: The staging area identified by the City at the NE end of Pond 2 may be used for temporary staging of the rock or earth fill. Unloading of the rock on access road is acceptable as long as the existing access road or newly compacted earthwork is not damaged due to this operation. However, the placement of the rock on the levee slopes shall be with an excavator, cranes equipped with clamshell, or similar equipment as stated in the specifications.

Response to Questions

1. **Question:** Please confirm all existing riprap is to be disposed of off-site?

Response: The existing riprap removed from the area of repair may be stockpiled in the identified locations on the WWTP property. This plan is contingent on the volume of removed riprap not exceeding the available space in the locations indicated below. Additionally, we need to maintain a minimum 20-foot perimeter around the stockpiled area to allow for adequate mobility and access. Any excess material will need to be disposed offsite by the contractor.



2. **Question:** Work with existing riprap does not show up in any of the Bid Schedule descriptions. If Los Banos would like to do something with existing riprap, what bid item does this apply to?

Response: Riprap to be used will conform to the specifications identified in Section 02371 Rockfill.
