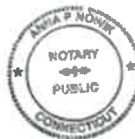

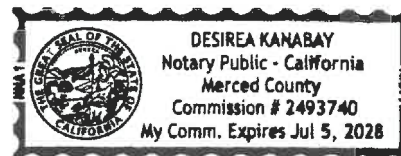

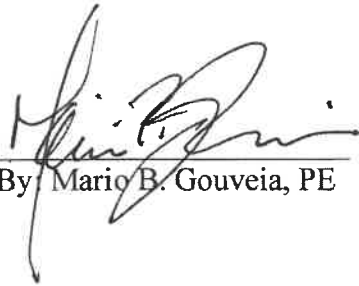

SECTION 6R
THERMOPLASTIC

1. GENERAL

Thermoplastic traffic striping and traffic markings shall be applied in accordance with the Drawings. Exact locations of striping and markings shall be as shown on the Drawings or as determined by the Engineer. Removal of existing striping and/or markings shall be done by grinding and vacuuming.

2. MATERIALS

Thermoplastic traffic stripes and pavement markings shall be in accordance with Section 84-2 of the State of California, Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications. All thermoplastic stripes and pavement markings shall contain glass beads.

Two-way reflective centerline markers shall be installed as required per plan and in accordance with Part 3 of the California MUTCD 2026 Edition.

3. MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Thermoplastic application shall be measured for payment per square foot of thermoplastic markings and linear foot of striping installed. A double 4-inch traffic stripe shall be measured as one traffic stripe. Payment shall be made at the applicable unit price bid in the Bid Schedule and shall include all compensation for removal of existing striping/markings, application of thermoplastic, installing reflective center line markers, blue reflective markers for fire hydrants, and all other appurtenant work.
