Massage Establishment Permit Application Submittal Requirements

- ☐ Completed Initial/Renewal Application
 - Business, occupation, or employment history of the applicant for ten (10) years preceding the date of application
 - Name and address of any massage business or other like establishment owned or operated by the applicant, the name of all partners and co-owners in each business, and a detailed description of any discipline, suspension, or revocation for each business
 - Description of any other business located within the City of Los Banos, even if not massage related, that is owned or operated by the applicant
 - Applicant shall specify the exact nature of the massage, bath, or health treatment to be administered
 - If the applicant is not the property owner(s), the property owner(s) shall authorize submittal of application.
 - Written description of the proposed Massage Establishment and how it will satisfy the requirements of the Los Banos Municipal Code pertaining Massage Establishments (Title 11, Chapter 16)
- ☐ Massage Establishment Permit application fee - \$232.04 Initial/Renewal
- ☐ Photo identification issued by a State agency proving that the applicant is at least eighteen (18) years of age (i.e. Driver's License)
- ☐ Proof of completed Livescan thru Los Banos Police Department
- ☐ Two (2) passport quality photographs of the applicant, which shall measure 2"x2" showing the head and shoulders of the applicant in a clear and distinguishing manner
- ☐ Establishment Owner's Massage Therapist Registration, if Establishment Owner will be providing massage services
- ☐ Register of all Massage Therapists and Practitioners associated with the Massage Establishment
- ☐ Copy of Massage Establishment's fee/services sheet
- ☐ Other required individual licenses and/or permits, if applicable

Note: The possession of a valid Massage Establishment Permit does not authorize the possessor to operate a business or perform work as a Certified Massage Therapist, Certified Massage Practitioner, or Exempt Massage Therapist. The Establishment must also be licensed by the City to conduct business. Permit issuance subject to Fire & Code Enforcement inspection clearance. In addition, staff may deem additional submittal information necessary.
